In addition to physical characteristics such as age or gender, people differ with respect to nationality or ethnicity, their cultural preferences, attitudes, qualifications, and their professions.

Yet how do such heterogeneities lead to social inequalities? What are the social mechanisms that underlie this process?

These are the questions pursued by the Collaborative Research Center (CRC) 882 "From Heterogeneities to Inequalities". More than fifty researchers from Bielefeld University, the German Institute for Economic Research (DIW) in Berlin and the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg are involved. The CRC conducts research on inequality in various fields, such as labor market, migration, justice, health, or gender. One goal of the CRC 882 is to integrate these fields, searching for common mechanisms in the emergence of inequality that can be consolidated into a typology.

The opening conference will be inaugurated on September 20th, 2012 with lectures and a panel discussion introducing the broad range of topics of the CRC 882 for a non-academic audience (in German).

The second conference day on September 21st, 2012 will start with a keynote address and then split up into three parallel workshop streams that will focus on the presentation and discussion of initial findings from the CRC's theoretical and empirical research in progress. The conference aims to provide a forum for exchanging the latest trends in research on social inequalities and a venue for its conceptual reorientation.
